### **WHY WORK AT AIDS CONNECTICUT?**

At AIDS Connecticut (ACT), we work with our member agencies to improve the lives of people impacted by HIV/AIDS through care and supportive services, housing assistance, advocacy, trainings and prevention. We are a non-profit organization that is passionate about our work and strive to lead through innovation, make measurable progress, collaborate for greater impact, and respect the choices of our clients.

Project TLC (Transitional Linkage to the Community) works with people living with HIV/AIDS who are currently incarcerated and will be released from prison shortly. Project TLC staff work to reconnect clients to community resources, housing, and HIV care.

### **WHAT WILL YOU DO AS PROJECT TLC PEER NAVIGATOR?**

You will do a lot! Most importantly, you will engage and support PLWHA in navigating the health care system, including providing information about HIV, adherence to medications, and goal planning. The goal is to increase clients' awareness of, and familiarity with, HIV health, housing, harm reduction, and social service systems.

Additionally, you will help clients obtain services through transportation to medical appointments, Department of Motor Vehicles, and the pharmacy. Providing emotional and practical support to clients recently released from incarceration is a large part of this job.

But wait, there's more! You will also participate in case conferences with a multidisciplinary team to present clients' concerns.

- Believe in our mission and core values
- Are excited by the job duties
- Are HIV+ and formerly incarcerated, and comfortable disclosing this information
- Are comfortable working in a sex positive environment where HIV/STIs, sexual behavior and prophylaxis are routinely discussed
- Demonstrate knowledge of HIV disease and progression
- Desire to work in a diverse workplace, serving diverse client base
- Familiarity with community resources
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing
- Experience with advocacy
- Understanding of HIPPA and confidentiality laws
- Must have a valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation
